- 8. If I proceed to trial and am found guilty, I may be allowed to seek suspension of some or all of the fines and jail upon condition of seeking treatment. I may seek treatment from public or private agencies at any time whether or not I am found guilty of the charge(s);
- 9. I know that a Petition for Deferred Prosecution will not be accepted if I sincerely believe that I am innocent of the charge(s) or if I do not believe that I suffer from alcoholism, drug addiction, or a mental health problem;
- 10. I have the right to appeal from any judgment of "Guilty" entered by this court after a plea of "Not Guilty" or "Not Guilty for the Record" following a trial or hearing thereon, by filing a written Notice of Appeal in this Court within thirty (30) days of judgment, specifying claims errors made by this Court, serving a copy of the Notice of Appeal on the Prosecutor and posting any appeal bond set by this Court.

A Deferred Prosecution is considered as a prior offense when imposing penalties and suspensions for subsequent offenses of Driving Under the Influence; Physical Control; Vehicular Homicide; and Vehicular Assault occurring within seven (7) years of the date of arrest for the above cause number(s). A person charged with a traffic infraction, misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor is only eligible for a Title 46 Deferred Prosecution once in a lifetime.

I hereby stipulate (agree) to the accuracy and admissibility of the police reports and any other documents, reports or evidence filed in this case (marked as an exhibit(s) and hereby admitted in this cause number), and further stipulate that in the event the Court revokes the Deferred Prosecution status, my guilt or innocence shall be determined by the Court considering only the police report(s) and any other documents, reports and evidence filed in this case at that time the Court accepts my Petition for Deferred Prosecution.
